We aim to enhance students' professional, social, and educational development through academic and social events and through community service work with underserved populations in the Hamilton community. With representatives from every program within the Faculty of Health Sciences, including medicine, nursing, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, midwifery, bachelor of health sciences, physician assistants, child life studies, speech language pathology and social work, our council advocates for and leads a movement towards interprofessional collaborative practice.

MISC Executive Role Descriptions

PUBLICITY & MULTIMEDIA COORDINATOR (2 positions):

- Increase the visibility of the group within the Faculty of Health Sciences to regularly recruit new council members.
- Create event advertisements to send to Program Year Representatives for distribution to their year and academic program.
- Ensure relevant information is advertised to FHS students through relevant media (Events and Rounds, Facebook, Avenue to Learn, website, etc.)
- Keep McMaster University website content up to date by liaising with the designated administrative support person on content change of website.
- Distribute and collect consent forms from participants present at events in order to take pictures. Responsible for taking pictures and posting them on the website as well.

EVENT LEADS

- Organize and lead an interprofessional based event
- Coordinate submission of event budgets to the co-chairs
- Coordinate submission of relevant event information to the Publicity Coordinator
- Book rooms, order food, and arrange gifts for guest speakers for all events
- Submit a Legacy Report summarizing all details of the event
- Attend exec meetings when necessary

PROGRAM REPRESENTATIVES (1 per level from medicine, nursing, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, midwifery, bachelor of health sciences, physician assistants, child life studies, social work, medical radiation and speech pathology):

- Publicize events amongst classmates
- Provide perspective/input to event leads, this includes reviewing event material and providing feedback to assure interprofessional inclusiveness
