

How to become a Midwifery Adjunct Professor

- 1. Have you contributed 150 hours for us as a preceptor in the past 3 years OR- are you currently the assigned preceptor for a midwifery student?
 - Yes Please make note of when and which courses. Proceed to step 2.
 - No Please take the New Preceptor Workshop and complete at least one course as a preceptor, before continuing with the Adjunct Appointment Application process.
- 2. Are you in good standing with the College of Midwives?
 - Yes Proceed to step 3.
 - **No** Your Application for Adjunct Appointment may not be approved.
- 3. Please complete the <u>Application for Appointment as Assistant Clinical</u> <u>Professor (Adjunct)</u>
- 4. Please upload the following documents to this <u>drop box</u>:
 - a. Your completed Application for Appointment as Assistant Clinical Professor (Adjunct)
 - b. An up-to-date CV outlining undergraduate and postgraduate training
 - c. Your list of **precepting history**
