

How to become a Midwifery Adjunct Professor

1. Have you contributed 150 hours for us as a preceptor in the past 3 years - OR- are you currently the assigned preceptor for a midwifery student?
 - **Yes** – Please make note of when and which courses. Proceed to step 2.
 - **No** – Please take the New Preceptor Workshop and complete at least one course as a preceptor, before continuing with the Adjunct Appointment Application process.
2. Are you in good standing with the College of Midwives?
 - **Yes** – Proceed to step 3.
 - **No** – Your Application for Adjunct Appointment may not be approved.

4. Please upload the following documents to this [drop box](#):
 - a. Your completed **Application for Appointment as Assistant Clinical Professor (Adjunct)**
